How to reach Giglio Island

Giglio Island is located in the southern part of the Tuscan Archipelago, facing the Argentario promontory. To reach the island, you need to take the **ferry from Porto Santo Stefano**, a locality of Monte Argentario that is easily accessible by car, train, or bus. The embarkation points are located at the entrance of the town. Two ferry companies offer multiple daily trips to Giglio Porto (check the schedules at https://www.giglioinfo.it/). From 7:30 AM to 7:30 PM, twelve trips are scheduled, one every hour. The return from Giglio Porto to Porto Santo Stefano follows the same timetable, starting at 9:00 AM until 7:00 PM (with the exception of a special trip at 6:00 AM).

The journey usually takes about an hour. Depending on your needs, you can decide whether to bring your car, rent a vehicle, or rely on public transportation. You will find a bus service that connects the three main localities; this is the Ig1R line with hourly departures from the port. To reach your event, you should get off at the Giglio Castello stop (the fifth stop). The return is guaranteed by the Ig1A line, which follows the same timetable towards Giglio Porto (check the schedules at https://www.giglioinfo.it/).
